Daughters of Charity Health Centers to host “Operation Turkeys, Toys & Treats” community toy and food distribution

On Saturday, December, 20, 2014, Daughters of Charity Health Centers, along with a host of other community organizations, will host a community toy and food distribution event. With the help of Coach Sean Payton's Play it Forward Foundation and Feed The Children, 400 families will receive a box of food, cleaning items and Avon products. With the help of the Greater New Orleans Pan-Hellenic council, each family will also receive a Winn-Dixie gift card to help in the purchase of a turkey. Other organizations such as L.A. Care Health Plan, Whole Foods Market, Kiwanis Westbank Konnection Club, First Books, and the Alpha Beta Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority have come together to provide this service to the children.

Through the U.S. Marine Corp's Toys For Tots Program, New Orleans, over 1,500 children who have preregistered through their school will receive a toy, coloring book and fresh fruit. Over 50 volunteers will be present to assist with this community project.
